

EXCERPTS FROM NEGAUNEE TOWNSHIP SNOW PLACEMENT CONTROL ORDINANCE

**ORDINANCE NO. 14**

Snow Placement Control Ordinance

THE TOWNSHIP OF NEGAUNEE ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. This Ordinance shall be known and cited as the "Snow Placement Control Ordinance of the Township of Negaunee".

SECTION 2. No person, firm, or corporation shall take or remove or cause to be taken or removed, any snow, ice, or other material from any property owned, occupied, rented, or controlled by him and pile or dump same within the right-of-way of any plowed road, street, or highway in the Township of Negaunee except as herein provided.

A. Snow may be removed from private property and piled in a plowed street, road or highway, but only parallel with and as apart of the bank of snow formed by the Township of Negaunee or the Marquette County Road Commission in their snow plowing operations. Such snow or ice shall be piled on the bank immediately in front of and adjacent to the property from which it is removed, and in no event shall the snow or ice so placed extend more than two feet six inches (2' 6") further into the roadway than the existing bank.

B. Snow may be piled on the bank adjacent to the property of another only with the express permission of the owner and/or occupant of said property, but shall not extend more than two feet six inches (2' 6") further into the roadway than the existing bank.

SECTION 3. No person, firm, corporation, or occupant shall take or remove, or cause to be removed, any snow, ice, or other material from any banks of snow formed by the Township of Negaunee or the Marquette County Road Commission in its plowing operation and pile, dump, or blow same within a plowed street, road, or highway in such manner as to reduce the width between the said formed banks of snow by more than two feet six inches (2' 6") on either side.

SECTION 4. Snow, ice, or other material moved, piled, or dumped in violation of this ordinance may be removed or caused to be removed by the Township of Negaunee or the Marquette County Road Commission and the expense of such removal charged to the party found in violation of the ordinance, said charges may be collected as "costs" in connection with a criminal conviction and/or by civil process.
